If you want to use the updated app, please update the mobile app.

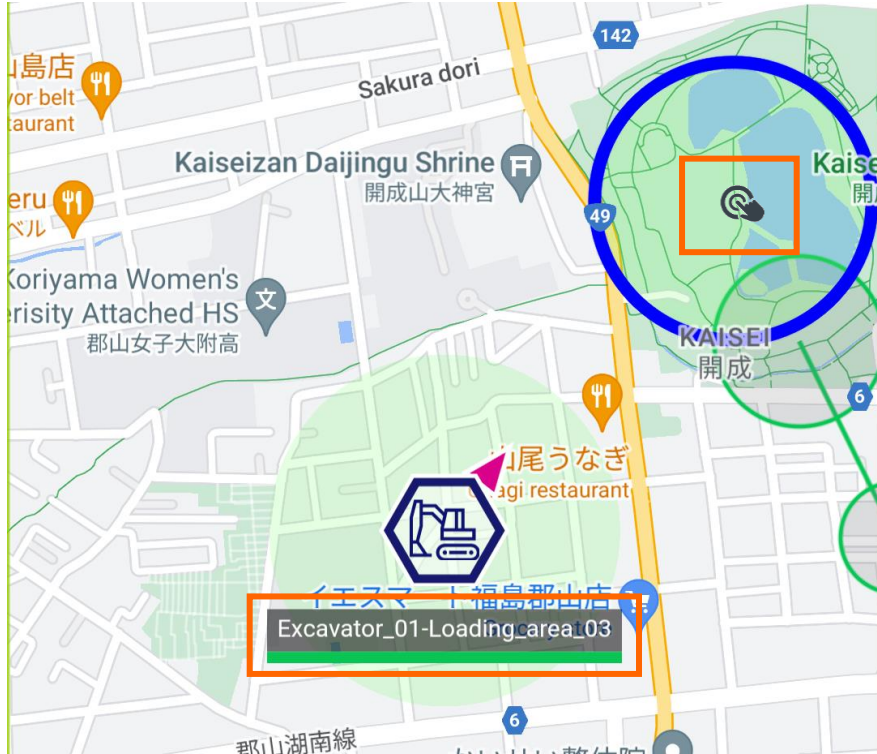
If you do not update, you can continue to use the current version.

[Feature Description]

When logging in with the vehicle role '**Loading Area**', the vehicle can belong to the **loading point**.

When logging in with the vehicle role '**Unloading Area**', the vehicle can belong to the **unloading point**.

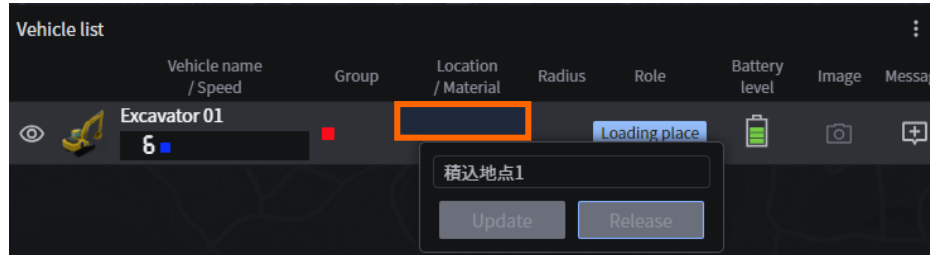
By belonging to a loading/unloading point, the vehicle will have a designated workplace radius around it and can function as a workplace.

Operation in the Mobile App

You can assign a vehicle to a desired workplace by tapping on it.

Operation in the Real-Time Viewer

Click on the "Location/Material" column in the "Vehicle List" to assign a vehicle to a workplace.

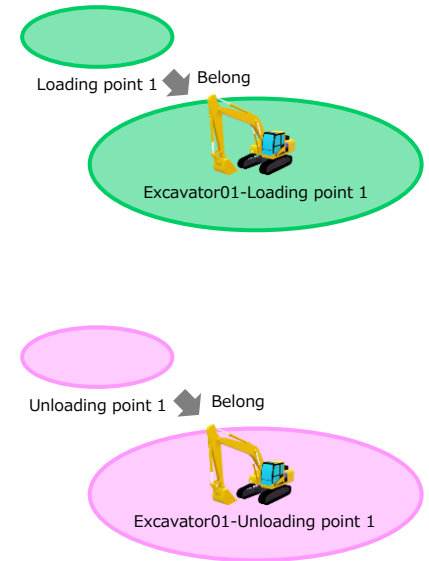


Pre-Release Specification (Before Ver. 5.11.0)

Logging out would clear the assigned workplace status.

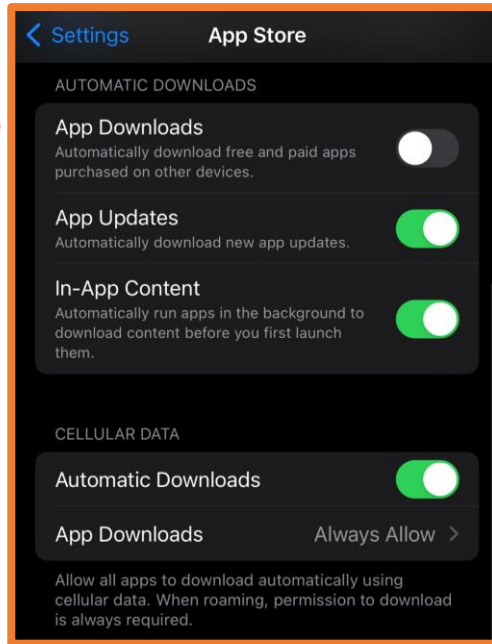
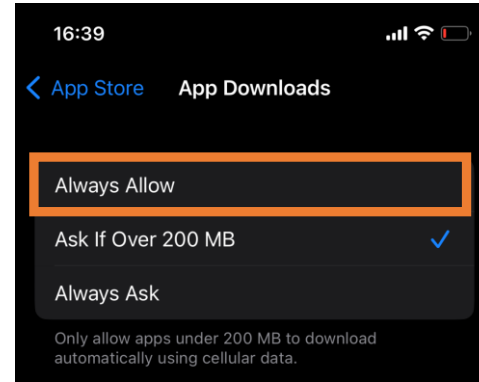
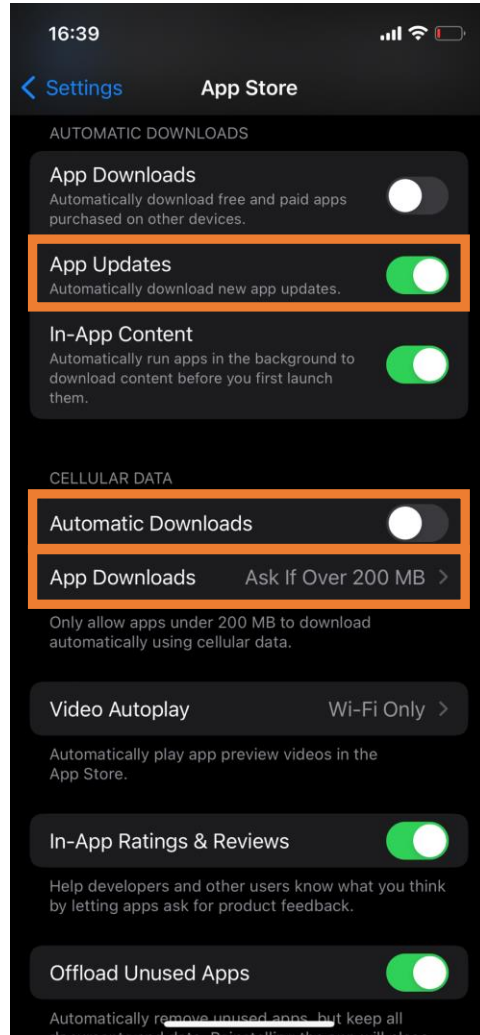
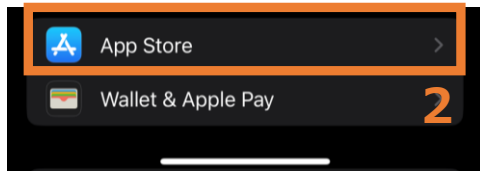
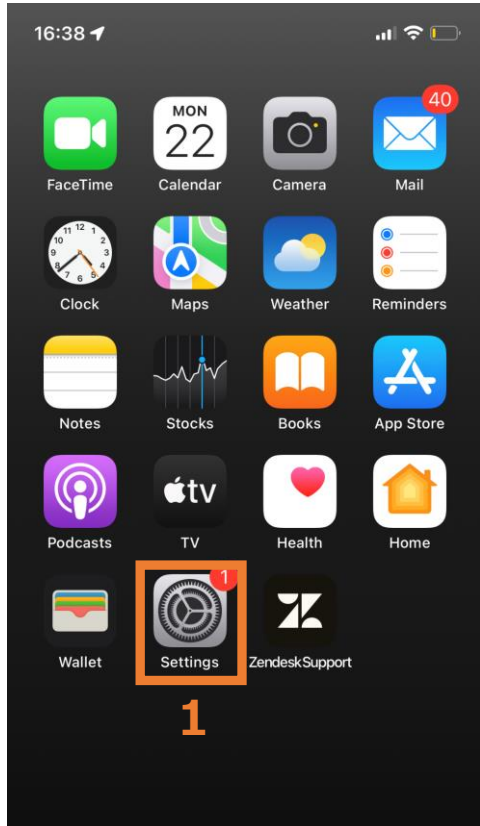
Post-Release Specification (From Ver. 5.11.1)

The assigned workplace status will no longer be cleared upon logout. The same settings will be retained and available upon the next login.

On iPhone, by pre-setting the following, the app will be automatically updated via mobile data when updated in the store.



✓ Android devices may have different settings menus depending on the manufacturer

1. Open the "Settings" app
2. Tap on "iTunes & App Store"
3. Turn on "App Updates"
4. Turn on "Automatic Downloads"
5. Tap on "App Downloads"
6. Choose "Always Allow"
7. Setting is finished
